CHALK—BOARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The chalkboard application is basically just a "PEEL and STICK".

- 1. Remove just HALF of the white backing paper and hold up the chalkboard to the wall—adjusting the position if necessary before letting the 'sticky side' touch the wall.
- 2. Once you are happy with the position, smooth down the exposed/sticky side onto the wall and carefully peel back the remaining white backing paper.
- 3. Rub over the entire surface with a spatula or credit card to smooth out any bubbles and help the adhesive to stick to the wall.
- 4. Slowly peel back the top layer of transfer tape—(if tape has been applied—) to reveal the chalkboard surface.
- 5. Write your messages using regular chalk or chalk markers*. A damp cloth works well for erasing the chalk for a 'clean slate'.
 - *when purchasing 'chalk markers' avoid 'PAPERMATE' brand. They don't seem to be compatible with our chalkboard vinyl.

The chalkboard vinyl can be repositioned*—but if it has small pieces cut out—that may make it more difficult to reposition. *Note: chalkboard vinyl can be repositioned on walls only. Smoother surfaces such as glass or stainless steel surfaces don't allow for repositioning.
